To support and develop the delivery of Children's Ministry and Community Work

Role description

Over the last year MBC has seen a significant increase in families with young children joining us. During this time we have also seen our work at Minchinhampton Community Hub expand. We are recruiting someone to work at both sites with a 50/50 time split to engage with existing activities and develop provision.

Key Responsibilities

- Focus on 'festival' events and socials; Christmas, Easter, Back to School, Mother's/ Father's Day, Halloween, Pentecost. Bringing children/youth/families and wider community together.
- Engage with and develop provision at Minchinhampton Community Hub (Minchkins toddler group, younger youth (school years 2-5), youth (school years 6-9), senior youth (school years 9+).
- Running and development of Sunday children's and creche groups.
- Support the delivery of 'All Age' worship gatherings.
- Encourage the faith journeys of children and their families.
- Work with other paid and volunteer ministry leaders.
- Develop positive relationships that encourage and empower volunteers.
- Engage with existing work at Minchinhampton Primary Academy (Assembly, Class talks, Curriculum advice).
